**Notes****Project – MASTER BUDGET**

Students will individually complete a project worth 10% of their total grade. The project will involve using Microsoft Excel to prepare an integrated master budget. This gives students an opportunity to apply the skills learned in Chapter 7 of the text, skills that embody a key concept in managerial accounting.

**Exams – Midterm & a Final**
